**Barmby Moor/Pocklington Parish Boundary**  
Up to 1901, the Barmby Moor parish boundary extended further east as far as Taylours Terrace, between Barmby Road and West Green. This area excluded the original Pocklington School built around 1514 but included Wilberforce Lodge, Dolman House and St. John's Lodge, built in the 1850s.  
The 50-acre area is marked as "Old Inclosure" on the Barmby Moor Enclosure map of 1783
