1. The first key memory is a somewhat sad memory, of being on a musicals trip to London in early Year 9 and one of the other pupils finding a newspaper with details of the bus crash. The news had been deliberately kept from us to allow us to enjoy the evening, but at that point we all crowded into one of the teachers' bedrooms in the hotel to be told the news. Many of the pupils were from the very musical primary school of Stamford Bridge, which was, of course, where the bus was going. Many had siblings and friends on the bus and some should have been on it.

2. A trip to Hellevoetshuis in the Netherlands with the school recorder group under David Grosvenor. We'd all learnt some Dutch phrases but discovered that the Dutch kids spoke better English than us, though with marked American accents due to the American TV they all watched.
